

Little Comfort Farm Course Fishing Lake Rules

- 1. Please **pay before you fish** (self ticketed/in the farm shop/as part of your cottage booking). Each ticket allows for the use of one rod.
- 2. All persons fishing over the age of 13 must be in possession of a current Environment Agency (EA) rod licence.
- 3. You need an EA rod licence for up to two rods, or two separate licences if you have three or four rods. This is the law of the land.
- 4. Day fishing is strictly between **7am-9pm**, 1st March to 31st December.
- 5. All nets/rods must be **clean and disinfected** before fishing.
- 6. **No keepnets** unless by explicit arrangement with the owners.
- 7. No barbed hooks, treble or multihook tackle permitted barbless hooks only.
- 8. No groundbait and boilies. If you have found sustainable versions of these, please let us know.
- 9. Unhooking mats are compulsory.
- 10. All hooks and lines must be out of the water when not fishing.
- 11. No interfering with the wildlife, plants, trees and shrubs.
- 12. No lighting fires or BBQs.
- 13. **No firearms or weapons** of any kind.
- 14. All radios and mobile phones must be **inaudible** to other anglers.
- 15. No making of **unnecessary noise** which could upset other anglers.
- 16. Please remove all litter, discarded fishing line and hooks.
- 17. Anyone found committing malicious damage will be banned from Little Comfort Farm.
- 18. All fish must be returned to the lake. Anyone removing fish will be prosecuted.
- 19. Always hold the fish low and carefully over a fishing mat to prevent injury from dropping.
- 20. One non-fishing guest is permitted per paying fisherman. This guest has access to the lake and fishing facilities only.
- 21. We undertake spot checks of tickets and tackle and reserve the right to immediately expel and/or ban any fishermen not complying with the rules (eg using barbed hooks).
